Programs supported by the Foundation have set the standard for high quality children's services across the country. Since 1966, these programs have used innovative techniques and highly trained professional staff to provide treatment and support while meeting the essential needs of all children. To date, more than 60,000 children have received support – children ranging from infancy to age 21, regardless of their ethnic, cultural or religious background.

The Foundation currently supports programs for children in California, Texas, Arizona, and Nevada through Trinity Youth Services and Advanced Education Services.
